

The Problem of Pet Over-Population:

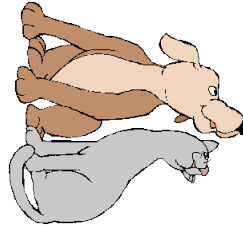
The Facts

According to the ASPCA:

- Approximately 6.5 million companion animals enter animal shelters nationwide every year. Of those, approximately 3.3 million are dogs and 3.2 million are cats. Each year, approximately 1.5 million animals are euthanized (670,000 dogs and 860,000 cats).
- The average number of litters a fertile cat produces can be three times a year; the average number of kittens is four to six per litter. The average number of litters a fertile dog produces is one to two a year; the average number of puppies is six to ten.
- The cost of spaying or neutering a pet is less than the cost of raising puppies or kittens for a year.

Spay/Neuter Benefits

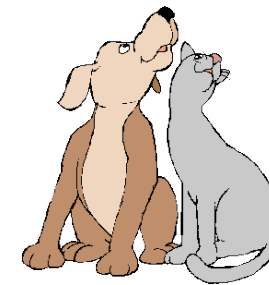
- No heat cycle, will not attract males.
- Risk of tumors or cancer in reproductive organs is reduced or eliminated.
- Reduces number of unwanted offspring.
- Reduces or eliminates the risk of spraying and marking.
- Less desire to roam, therefore, less likely to be injured in fights or auto accidents.
- Decreases aggressive behavior including dog bites.

📍 For locations, exact prices, information and appointments, please go to PFAonline.org or call 973-454-1625.

🐾 **SURGERIES:** include the spay (female) or neuter (male) surgery, an Elizabethan collar and post operative pain medication.

- Feline (cat) spay or neuter = ~\$76
- Feline (cat) feral - please call for price
- Canine (dog) neuter up to 50lbs. = ~\$112
- Canine (dog) spay up to 50lbs. = ~\$122
- Dogs greater than 50lbs., call for price

📍 **VACCINES:** price range \$19 - \$30

- Rabies
- DA2PP (Canine distemper)
- Canine Bordatella
- Canine Influenza
- Lyme
- Leptospirosis
- FVRCP (Feline distemper)
- Feline FeLV

🐾 **Tests/Preventative/etc.:** price range \$10 - \$40

- 4DX Test (Heartworm/lyme/Anap/Her.)
- Feline combo (FeLV/FIV) test
- Flea and Tick treatment
- Microchipping
